




FAVORITE VEGETABLES

One day, Tucker ran away for a week. He went to his next door neighbor's house because he got in trouble with Nicole, his owner. He was biting up her shoes and


clothes and got in trouble.


Nicole was disappointed in herself. She looked for him. She heard him bark. She knocked on the neighbor's door and said, "Is my dog here?"

Danny is a good dog. He is a Rough Coat Collie. This is his story.



Dan said, "O.K."


So, for the rest of the week, they went to the mall and the pet store. (LaNiyah)

now I think, "Will the supercat fish turn me into a superdog fish?"


Oh, no! She did! I am a superdog fish, but... Now I am hoping someone will save me.


Later, he accidentally drank a different potion and turned back into a dog. At the end, he felt better and said he was happy that he was a dog again! (Truth)


Paisley ran out of her house because she heard on the phone that there was someone who needed help. She ran to that address and


Paisley in the Snow

mom said, "Thank you for the yogurt."


Roxy was so smart that she started going to dog school. She plays at gym. She has two best friends, Jemire and Olivia. They play tag.
