

Explorers were asked to complete the sentence beginning with "I love..." or "I


love to..." Here's what they had to say!

I know I have a little bit of hate, but I also know what's right and what's wrong, so focus on the love, stop the hate. Treat each


other kindly.

In charge of the world.




If I were President of the United States, I'd cancel school, homework, snow, onions and big tomatoes.

Artist Andrew Illene visited Explorers and showed us how to paint a simple Cityscape. Here are the paintings the Explorers created.






ODYSSEY JUMPSTART


