
### COPING WITH COVID-19


An important woman is my mom. She takes care of me, gives me food and shelter. (**D'Angelo**)


#### SUPERPOWERS




I would like the super powers of invisibility, fastness, and the power to control the earth and people (mind power) and make them evil. I want this power to have control. (Alex)



I don't want a super power because it's not fair for me to have powers and nobody else. (Blessing)






I want to have every single power that protects you and gets you away from evil people. I would also like a Ferrari 599. (**Devvin**)
